- 2) Putting the repeller into operation The vibrations are emitted in all directions. Choose a place in the middle of the affected area or you can place multiple repellers in the distance of approx. 20 m from each other. The efficiency of the repeller depends on the soil type and properties.
- a) Unscrew the cap by turning it counter-clockwise and remove the battery case.
- b) Insert 4x D batteries. Pay attention to the correct polarity.
- c) Insert the battery case back. Put the cap back on, properly press it, and turn it clockwise to secure it.
- d) The buzzer works for 3 seconds. Then there is a 30-second pause. After 10 cycles, the motor will start vibrating for 3 seconds. Then there is a 30-second pause again. After the third motor cycle, the buzzer cycle starts again.
- e) Insert the repeller at least 20 cm into the ground. Do not use a hammer or brute strength during the installation, because it might cause damage to the device.
